**General Notice:**

Mancos Water Conservancy District (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project: MWCD – Jackson Gulch Drop Chute .

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Mancos Water Conservancy District Office located at 42599 Road N, Mancos, Colorado 81328 or electronically at [katie.a@jonesanddemille.com](mailto:katie.a@jonesanddemille.com) with a courtesy copy (cc) to [ty.k@jonesanddemille.com](mailto:ty.k@jonesanddemille.com), until Wednesday, July 29, 2026, at 3:00pm local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work: Replace concrete drop chute and stilling basin. Existing chute drops approximately 225 feet in elevation over 700 horizontal feet. Replace existing chute with dual HDPE pipe chute and concrete inlet and outlet structure adjacent to existing structure. Includes removing section of concrete channel and constructing new concrete intake structure, installation of 100 linear feet of 54-inch DR 26 HDPE pipe, 1,400 linear feet of 42-inch HDPE DR 21 pipe, with associated appurtenances and fittings, constructing impact basin outlet structure, widening existing channel and installing riprap apron and other general site work. The 54 inch and 42-inch pipe and fittings have been procured under separate contract.

Bids will be received for single contract.

Owner anticipates that the Project's total bid price will be approximately \$1,175,000. The Project has an expected duration of 10 weeks with start date no earlier than August 17, 2026. The project site is at an elevation of approximately 7,800 ft with variable winter conditions. It is the contractor's responsibility to work within weather and site constraints to achieve substantial completion on or before December 17, 2026, and Final completion on or before December 31, 2026.

**Domestic Preference:**

This project is subject to the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), Pub. L. 117-58, §§ 70901-70953 and Davis-Bacon Act prevailing wage rates. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States. Davis-Bacon and related Acts apply to all contractors and subcontractors performing on federally funded projects.
